

Classification of Orchestra NV & Sub-NV Groups Entering UIL Concert & Sightreading

Entering Non Varsity or Sub-Non Varsity Groups

1A/2A/3A/4A/5A & C/CC/CCC Schools:

- When a Full orchestra is entered, the first full orchestra must be designated as Varsity Full. The Second group would be designated as NV Full and additional groups designated as Sub NV Full.
- String orchestras may be entered as a NV String provided that a varsity full orchestra or varsity string orchestra from that school is also entered. String students may compete in both the varsity full and non varsity string groups.
- String students may not compete in two string groups.
- In the event a full orchestra, varsity string orchestra and NV string orchestra are entered, string students may compete in either the varsity string orchestra or the NV string orchestra.
- Possible entries for NV groups are allowed as follows:
 - Varsity Full & Varsity String & NV String with all others designated as Sub-NV String
 - Varsity Full & NV String with all others designated as Sub-NV String

Sightreading Timing Extension for Sub-Non Varsity Full and String Groups

- Groups designated as Sub-NV are allowed one extra minute in their sightreading instructional period designated by their conference.
