

UIL RULE CHANGES FOR 2009-10

1. Section 1102 (b)(1) - Students enrolled in more than one music class.

(A) A student playing a wind or percussion instrument in a varsity or non-varsity concert band may play a keyboard instrument (piano, celeste, synthesizer, etc.) or harp in another competing concert band representing the same school.

(B) A student enrolled in more than one instrumental music class may participate in the group representing each class provided the student is performing on a different instrument.

2. Section 1108 (i)(2) – Consistent penalty for students failing to comply with S&E Performance Requirements

Failure to comply with performance requirements as defined in the Prescribed Music List shall result in disqualification.

3. Section 1111(g)(8) – New 4A & 5A sightreading option for mixed choirs

SAB Music Selection. Choral groups performing a majority of SATB music in their concert competition will be required to sightread SATB music designated for that conference. However, choirs in all conferences may sightread SAB music provided that their program includes a majority of SAB music.
